## Highlights on 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN 2015)

### MUNICIPALITY OF SAN JOSE

- The population of the Municipality of San Jose, Antique as of August 1, 2015 was 62,534 based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN 2015).
- The 2015 population is higher by 1,839 compared with the population of 32,494 in 2010, and higher by 4,815 and 6,686 compared with 2007 and 2000, respectively. Refer to Table 1.

- The Municipality of San Jose population increased by 1.49 percent annually, on average, during the period 2010 to 2015. By comparison, this growth rate is slower than at which the province grew during the period 2000 to 2010 and from 2007 to 2010 at a rate of 1.83 percent and 1.94 percent, respectively. See Table 2.

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- Of the municipality's 28 barangays, Funda-Dalipe had the biggest population in 2015 with 5,879 persons. The other top four barangays include San Pedro (5,735), Barangay 8 (Pob.) (4,689), Maybato Norte (4,219) and Barangay 3 (Pob.) (3,384). The combined population of these five (5) barangays accounted for almost 38.2 percent of San Jose's population in 2015. See Table 3.

- Barangay 7 (Pob.) was the smallest barangay in terms of population size with 395 persons. Four other barangays at the bottom five, namely Barangay 6 (Pob.) (489), Durog (496), Pantao (756) and Bugarot (Catungan-Bugarot) (946).

- The barangay of Durog was the fastest growing barangay with an average annual population growth rate (PGR) of 11.50 percent. The second fastest growing barangay with an average annual population growth rate at 7.09 percent from 2010 to 2015 was Cansadan (Cansadan-Tubudan), followed by Maybato Sur at 5.43 percent, San Fernando at 3.30 percent and Madrangca at 3.00 percent. - San Jose has a population density of 1,288 persons in every square kilometer. This is higher by 97 persons per square kilometer in 2010 with population density of 1,191 with a percent change of 8.1 percent from 2010-2015.
- The population of San Jose in 2015 which was 62,534 is 10.74 percent of the total population of Antique which was 582,012 in the same year.

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- The POPCEN was undertaken by the Philippine Statistics Authority in August 2015 pursuant to Republic Act No. 10625, also known as the Philippine Statistical Act of 2013 and executive Order 352- Designation of Statistical Activities That Will Generate Critical Data for Decision-Making of the Government and the Private Sector, which stipulates the conduct of a mid-decade census primarily to update the population in all barangays nationwide.
  - Information on the count of the population was collected with 12:01 a.m. of August 1, 2015 as the census reference time and date.
  - His Excellency President Benigno S. Aquino III declared as official for all purposes the population counts of the province, city/municipality, and barangay, based on the POPCEN 2015 under Proclamation No. 1269 dated 18 May 2016. The population counts were based on census questionnaires accomplished by about 750 enumerators and supervisors deployed during the nationwide census taking.
  - The successful completion of the census-taking was made possible with the support of the local and national officials, government agencies, local government units, media, private agencies, and non-government organizations.
