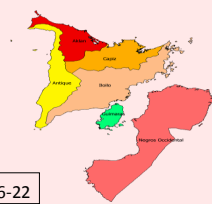

Consumer Price Index (CPI)

The CPI is an indicator of the changes in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.













Inflation Rate

Inflation Rate is the rate of change of the CPI expressed in percent. Inflation is interpreted in terms of declining purchasing power of the peso.

Purchasing Power of the Peso (PPP)

PPP shows how much the peso in the base period is worth in the current period. It is computed as the reciprocal of the CPI for the
