



A. Western Visayas

1. Headline Inflation

Western Visayas headline inflation or overall inflation slowed down further to 4.0 percent in November 2023, from 5.4 percent in October 2023. The inflation rate in November 2022 was higher at 9.6 percent. Regional average inflation from January to November 2023 is at 7.2 percent. (Table A, Figure 1, and Table D)

1.1 Main Drivers to the Downward Trend of the Headline Inflation

The downtrend in the headline inflation in November 2023 was mainly brought about by the slower annual increase in the heavily weighted index of Food and non-alcoholic beverages at 8.0 percent in November 2023 from 8.9 percent in October 2023. Next is Transport with -1.9 percent annual decrease from 1.4 percent inflation in the previous month. Also contributing to the deceleration is Housing, water electricity, gas and other fuels, with -3.1 percent annual decline in November 2023, from -2.1 percent in October 2023.

Lower inflation rates were also noted in the indices of the following commodity groups during the month:

- a. Restaurants and accommodation services, 6.8 percent from 9.6 percent;
- b. Personal care, and miscellaneous goods and services, 4.1 percent from 5.7 percent;
- c. Furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance, 4.8 percent from 6.7 percent;
- d. Clothing and footwear, 3.0 percent from 4.1 percent;
- e. Information and communication, 0.7 percent from 2.1 percent;
- f. Alcoholic beverages and tobacco, 9.9 percent from 11.0 percent, and
- g. Recreation, sport and culture, 5.7 percent from 6.7 percent

Meanwhile, higher inflation rate was observed in the index of Health with 2.9 percent in November 2023, from 2.6 pecent in the previous month.

Education services (7.8 percent) and Financial services (0.0 percent) retained their previous month's inflation rates. (Table B).

1.2 Main Contributors to the Headline Inflation

The top commodity groups contributing to the Western Visayas headline inflation rate of 4.0 percent in November 2023 were the following:

- a. Food and non-alcoholic beverages with 82.6 percent share or 3.3 percentage points;
- b. Restaurants and accommodation services with 10.2 percent share or 0.41 percentage point, and
- c. Alcoholic beverages and tobacco with 6.2 percent share or 0.3 percentage point.

2. Food Inflation

Food inflation in Western Visayas during November 2023 went down to 8.2 percent, from 9.2 percent in October 2023. Food inflation in November 2022 was recorded at 10.4 percent. (Table C)

2.1 Main Drivers to the Downtrend of Food Inflation

The deceleration of food inflation in November 2023 was mainly brought about by the slower annual growth of Vegetables, tubers, plantains, cooking bananas and pulses commodity group, with inflation rate of 7.8 percent in November 2023 from 19.2 percent inflation rate in October 2023. Second main driver to the downtrend of food inflation is the food group of Fish and other seafood with 8.0 inflation rate during the month from 9.1 percent inflation rate in the previous month. Sugar, confectionery and desserts food group also contributed to the downtrend with 1.7 percent inflation rate in November 2023 from 5.8 percent in October 2023.

Slower inflation rates were also noted in the indices of the following food groups:

- a. Milk, other dairy products and eggs, 7.0 percent from 8.2 percent;
- b. Ready-made food and other food products n.e.c., 6.0 percent from 7.8 percent;
- c. Fruits and nuts, 7.6 percent from 8.7 percent, and
- d. Oils and fats, 6.8 percent from 10.0 percent.

In contrast, higher inflation rates were noted in the food groups of Cereals and cereal products, at 8.1 in November 2023 from 7.1 percent in October, and Meat and other parts of slaughtered land animals with 12.3 annual growth in November from 8.9 percent inflation rate in October 2023.

2.2 Main Contributors to the Food Inflation

Food had a share of 79.3 percent or 3.17 percentage points to November 2023 Western Visayas headline inflation. Food groups with the biggest contribution to food inflation of 8.2 percent during the month were the following:

- a. Cereals and cereal products with, which includes rice, corn, flour bread and other bakery products with 38.0 percent share or 3.1 percentage points;
- b. Meat and other parts of slaughtered land animals with 21.6 percent share or 1.8 percentage points, and
- c. Fish and other seafood with 17.2 percent share or 1.4 percentage points.

3. Inflation Rate for the Bottom 30% Income Households

November 2023 inflation rate for the Bottom 30% Income Households in Western Visayas decelerated further to 5.0 percent from 6.2 percent inflation rate in October 2023. Inflation rate for Bottom 30% income households was higher in November 2022, at 10.6 percent inflation rate. (Table E)

3.1 Main Drivers to Downtrend of Bottom 30% Income Households Inflation

The slowdown in inflation rate for Bottom 30% Income Households was mainly brought about by the slower year-on-year increase in the index of Food and Non-alcoholic beverages, with inflation rate of 8.0 percent in November 2023, from 8.7 percent in the previous month. Next is Transport with -1.0 percent annual decrease from 2.9 percent inflation rate in October 2023. Housing, water, electricity, gas, and other fuels commodity group also contributed with annual decrease of -5.5 percent during the month, from -4.2 percent decline in October 2023. (Table F)

B. Provinces

Five out of the six provinces in Western Visayas except Guimaras recorded deceleration in inflation rates in November 2023 from October 2023. Guimaras had the highest monthly inflation rate of 5.8 percent, while lloilo had the lowest at 3.2 percent.

Both highly urbanized cities in the region registered slowdown in their inflation rates during the month. Iloilo City monthly inflation rate is at 1.6 percent and Bacolod City monthly inflation rate is noted at 4.2 percent. (Table G)
