## PSA Rolls Out Demographic Information Updating Services for National ID System in Select Provinces in Region 6

Citizens update their demographic information for the National ID, ensuring accurate and up-to-date records for national identification purposes.

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) has initiated the gradual rollout of services to update demographic information in the National ID system across select provinces. This update allows registered individuals to change or correct entries such as name, marital status, sex, date or place of birth, address, blood type, and correct any clerical and/or typographical errors.

As of June 3, 2024, the updating services are available in 54 PSA Provincial Statistical Offices (PSOs) nationwide. In Region 6, five out of six provinces have registration centers equipped to handle demographic updating needs. Later this June, the province of Guimaras will also have these services available, ensuring comprehensive coverage throughout the region.



Additionally, for registered persons needing to replace National IDs with peeled-off photos, they may surrender their ID at the nearest registration center or PSA Regional Statistical Services Office (RSSO) and PSO and fill out a request form.

The PSA remains committed to providing efficient and accessible services to the public, ensuring that the information in the National ID system is accurate and up-to-date.
