Technological University of the Philippines-Visayas Triumphs in 28th Philippine Statistics Quiz Regional Championship

Iloilo City, Philippines — The Technological University of the Philippines-Visayas (TUP-V) emerged as champion during the 28th Philippine Statistics Quiz (PSQ) Regional Championship held on 08 November 2024 at the Diversion 21 Hotel, Mandurriao, Iloilo City.

Mr. Resh S. Garcia, representing TUP-V and guided by his coach, Engr. Kevin Claveras, secured the top spot in this highly anticipated regional competition, organized by the Philippine Statistics Authority Regional Statistical Services Office (PSA RSSO) VI.

The regional championship brought together seventeen (17) representatives from various schools and provinces, all of whom earned their place in the competition by excelling at the PSQ-Provincial Level. The PSQ, an annual nationwide competition that began in 1992, aims to promote awareness and appreciation of statistics among Filipino youth. It is jointly spearheaded by the PSA and the Philippine Statistical Association, Inc. (PSAI).



Achieving 2nd place in the regional championship was Mr. Yel Pogoy of the University of the Philippines Visayas (UPV), while Mr. Charles Lawrence Benares of Colegio de San Agustin- Bacolod claimed the third spot.

Mr. Garcia will represent Western Visayas in the 28th PSQ National Championship to be held on 05 December 2024 in Manila, where he will compete against other regional champions from across the country.
