PhilSys and DSWD Enhance Service Delivery for 4Ps Beneficiaries in Region 6

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Region 6 and the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Region 6 have achieved remarkable progress in their joint efforts to bring the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) closer to Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries in Western Visayas.

As of December 2024, a total of 261,120 4Ps beneficiaries in Region 6 have undergone biometric authentication through PhilSys. This initiative ensures accurate identity verification, enabling more efficient delivery of social services to beneficiaries across the region.

From October to December 2024, PhilSys successfully registered an additional 6,176 individuals in Region 6, further strengthening the implementation of the program. This



accomplishment aligns with the recently issued guidelines recognizing PhilSys registration as a compliance activity during Family Development Sessions (FDS).

This partnership between PSA Region 6 and DSWD Region 6 integrates PhilSys registration and authentication into the FDS, a core requirement for 4Ps beneficiaries to receive their conditional cash grants. The initiative prevents duplication and ensures that services reach the intended beneficiaries, enhancing the integrity and efficiency of social protection programs in the region.

The success of the colocation effort underscores the commitment of both agencies to leverage innovative solutions in improving the lives of Filipinos. PSA Region 6 and DSWD Region 6 remain steadfast in their mission to achieve full registration of all 4Ps beneficiaries, ensuring that no one is left behind in accessing essential government services.
