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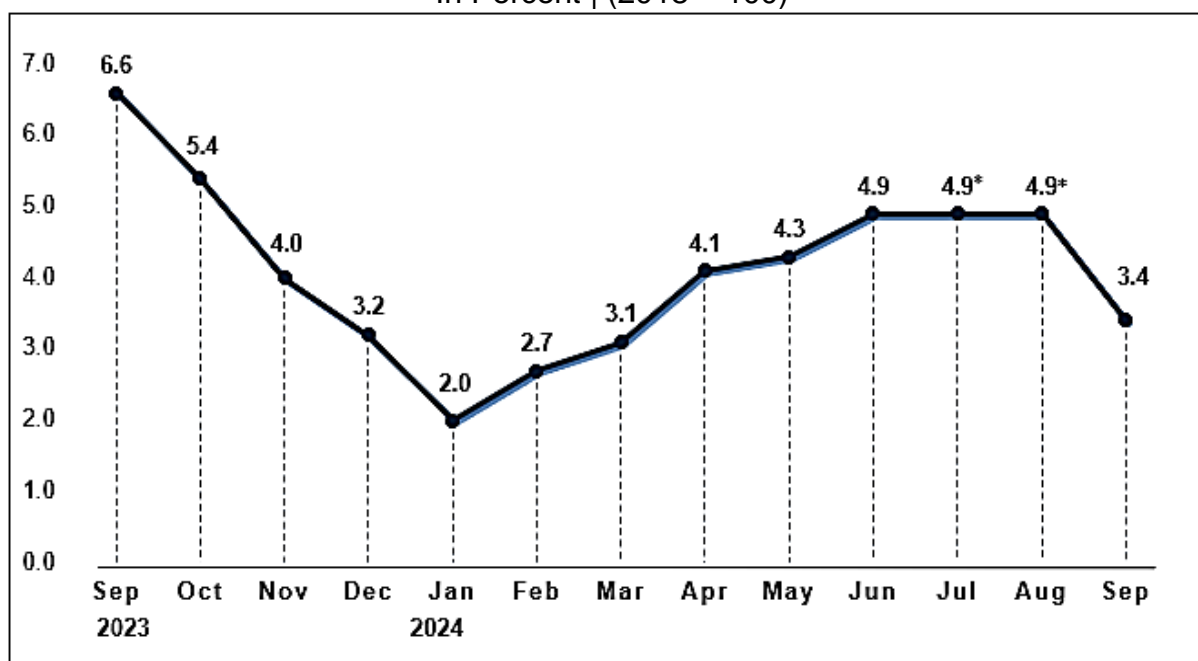

## A. Western Visayas

### 1. Headline Inflation

Western Visayas' headline inflation decreased to 3.4 percent in September 2024, from 4.9 percent in August 2024. The regional average inflation rate from January to September 2024 is 3.8 percent. In September 2023, the inflation rate was higher at 6.6 percent. (Table A, Figure 1, and Table D)

#### 1.1 Main Drivers to the Downtrend of the Headline Inflation

The deceleration in the Western Visayas inflation rate in September 2024 was mainly due to the slower annual growth in the index of Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages, which was noted at 3.3 percent during the month from 6.2 percent in August 2024. Transport was the second top contributor to the downtrend, which had -2.1 percent inflation in September from 0.7 percent in August 2024.

Additionally, lower inflation was noted in the Education Services index, at 8.1 percent from 10.3 percent; Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco at 3.3 percent from 3.7 percent; Recreation Sports and Culture at 3.8 percent from 4.2 percent; Restaurants and Accommodation Services at 6.1 percent from 6.2 percent, and Personal Care and Miscellaneous Goods and Services at 2.8 percent from 3.2 percent in the preceding month.

In contrast, higher inflation rates were noted in the following commodity groups during the month:

- Clothing and Footwear, 3.8 percent from 3.6 percent;
- Furnishings, Household Equipment, and Routine Household Maintenance, 2.5 percent from 2.4 percent, and
- Health, 3.1 percent from 3.0 percent;

The indices of Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas, and other Fuels recorded inflation rates of 5.6 percent, Information and Communication at 0.9 percent, and Financial Services at -1.0 percent, which were similar to the previous month's annual growth (Table B).

### *1.2 Main Contributors to the Headline Inflation*

The top three commodity groups contributing to the Western Visayas headline inflation rate of 3.4 percent in September 2024 were the following:

- a. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages with 41.2 percent share or 1.40 percentage points;
- b. Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas, and other fuels with 30.8 percent share or 1.05 percentage points, and
- c. Restaurants and Accommodation Services with 11.1 percent share or 0.38 percentage point

## **2. Food Inflation**

Food inflation in Western Visayas declined to 3.4 percent in September 2024 from 6.5 percent in August 2024. (Table C)

### *2.1 Main Drivers of the Downtrend in Food Inflation*

The downtrend in food inflation in September 2024 was due to lower annual growth in the index of Vegetables, Tubers, Plantains, Cooking Bananas, and Pulses, with -8.9 percent inflation rate in September 2024 from 2.4 percent in August. This was followed by Cereals and Cereal Products, with 9.9 percent inflation rate from 12.1 percent in August 2024. Meat and other parts of the slaughtered land animals' food group also contributed to the downtrend with 8.0 percent inflation rate in September from 13.1 percent in August.

Lower inflation rates were also noted in Fish and other seafood at -4.5 percent from -2.7 percent; Oils and fats at -1.8 percent from -1.7 percent; Fruits and Nuts from 9.2 percent from 11.0 percent, and Ready-made food and other food products n.e.c. at 6.0 percent from 6.6 percent.

In contrast, higher inflation rates were observed in the index of Sugar, Confectionery, and Desserts, at -3.8 percent from -4.0 percent. On the other hand, the index of Milk and other dairy products remained unchanged at 3.5 percent inflation from the previous month.

### *2.2 Main Contributors to the Food Inflation*

Food had a share of 39.5 percent or 1.34 percentage points to Western Visayas' headline inflation rate in September 2024 (Table B). The top three food groups with the highest contribution to food inflation of 3.4 percent during the month were the following (Table C):

- a. Cereals and cereal products with 90.2 percent share or 3.07 percentage points;
- b. Meat and other parts of slaughtered land animals with 27.2 percent share or 0.93 percentage points, and
- c. Fruits and nuts with 9.8 percent share or 0.33 percentage point.

### 3. Inflation Rate for the Bottom 30% Income Households

The inflation rate for the Bottom 30% Income Households in Western Visayas decelerated to 4.0 percent in September 2024 from 5.9 percent in August 2024. The inflation rate for the Bottom 30% income households was higher in September 2023, at 7.9 percent. (Table E)

#### 3.1 Main Drivers to Downtrend of Bottom 30% Income Households Inflation

The downtrend in the inflation rate for the Bottom 30% Income Households was primarily brought about by the slower annual growth in the index of Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages at 3.9 percent in September 2024 from 6.9 percent in August 2024. This was followed by Transport with lower annual growth of -4.1 percent inflation rate from -1.3 percent in the previous month. The Recreation, Sport, and Culture commodity group, with a lower inflation rate of 5.5 percent during the month from 6.9 percent in August, also contributed to the downtrend. (Table F)

## B. Provinces

All provinces in Western Visayas recorded a deceleration in inflation rates from August to September 2024. Aklan had the lowest monthly inflation rate, at 2.3 percent, while Guimaras had the highest, at 4.7 percent.

Both highly urbanized cities in the region recorded a downtrend in their inflation rates during the month. Iloilo City's monthly inflation rate is at 2.8 percent from 3.7 percent in August 2024, and Bacolod City at 3.9 percent from 5.7 percent in the previous month. (Table G)
