Western Visayas 35th Civil Registration Month Motorcade and Opening Ceremony.

ILOILO CITY – On 03 February 2025, at Robinsons Place Jaro, Iloilo City, the 35th Civil Registration Month (CRM) unfolded as a joint endeavor led by the Philippine Statistics



Authority Regional Statistical Services Office VI (PSA RSSO VI), headed by Officer-in-Charge Nelida C. Amolar. The event, themed "*Building a Resilient, Agile, and Future-Fit Civil Registration and Vital Statistics System*," exemplified strong cooperation with Regional Line Agencies and Local Government, emphasizing a collective dedication to developing a civil registration framework that is flexible, responsive, and continuously evolving to meet the public's needs.

The event began with a vibrant motorcade, showcasing the active involvement of members of Regional Interagency Committee on Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (RIACCRVS) in Western Visayas. It was followed by a celebratory opening at Robinsons Place Jaro. During the activity, OIC Regional Director Nelida C. Amolar delivered her inspiring message, highlighting the importance of accurate and timely registration in safeguarding individual rights and ensuring access to essential services. OIC-RD also introduced PSA services, including the mobile CRS, which allows clients to obtain their documents on-site. The program continued with a Zumba session, accompanied by the PSA and Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (CRVS) Jingle, led by PSA RSSO 06 personnel. Following this, Supervising Statistical Specialist Ma. Goretti M. Novilla delivered an insightful presentation on the vital statistics of Western Visayas.

OIC Regional Director Amolar officially declared the opening of the 2025 Civil Registration Month Celebration, marking the start of a month-long initiative dedicated to promoting awareness and understanding of the vital role civil registration plays in society. Closing the event, Chief Administrative Officer William G. Jaro expressed his heartfelt gratitude to all participants for their unwavering support and dedication to promoting civil registration awareness.

In addition, the PSA RSSO 06 set up a Mobile CRS booth at the activity center, providing mallgoers with the convenient service of requesting and obtaining their civil registry documents on-site. Alongside this, the Regional Alternative Child Care Office VI (RACCO VI) also established a booth offering consultations on adoption and alternative childcare options. RACCO's presence provided valuable information and guidance to those interested in understanding the legal and procedural aspects of adoption, fostering awareness and support for families in need of alternative childcare solutions. These services were available from February 3 to 5, 2025.

The CRM opening showcased a broader commitment to strengthening this civil registration system and emphasized the importance of accurate, timely registration in safeguarding individual rights and ensuring access to vital services. As the month-long celebration continues, it serves as a reminder of the essential role civil registration plays in building a resilient, agile, and future-fit society, ensuring its continued effectiveness in serving the public's needs.
