PSA Region 6 Brings National ID Registration and Civil Registration Services to Trabaho sa Bagong Pilipinas Job Fair

Amolar and PSA RSSO 6 staff participated in the Trabaho sa Bagong Pilipinas Job Fair in Iloilo City, facilitating National ID registration, updating, and authentication services, as well as a Civil Registration Information Booth to assist job seekers and 4Ps beneficiaries in securing valid proof of identity for employment and social services.

Iloilo City, February 13, 2025 – The Philippine Statistics Authority Regional Statistical Services Office VI (PSA RSSO 6) joined the Trabaho sa Bagong Pilipinas Job Fair, providing National ID registration, updating, authentication services, and a Civil Registration Information Booth to support job seekers and government service beneficiaries.

The job fair, spearheaded by the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) in collaboration with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), attracted approximately 2,500 attendees, including employers from various industries. The event aimed to match job seekers with employment opportunities, equipping them with skills aligned with available job openings. President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr.



attended the event and emphasized the government's commitment to providing comprehensive employment assistance. He highlighted the importance of job matching, ensuring that job seekers' skills align with available opportunities. He also reaffirmed the administration's dedication to making government services more accessible to Filipinos, particularly those seeking employment and social protection.

PSA RSSO 6 played a crucial role in the event by facilitating National ID registration and authentication services, ensuring 4Ps beneficiaries and job seekers had access to a valid proof of identity essential for employment and social services. The Civil Registration Information Booth provided assistance on birth, marriage, and death registration concerns, reinforcing PSA's commitment to ensuring every Filipino has access to legal identity documentation. The PSA's participation also aligned with DSWD's equivalency period for Q1 2025, further supporting the registration of 4Ps beneficiaries and ensuring they meet identification requirements for social protection programs.

PSA RSSO 6 remains committed to bringing National ID services closer to the people, supporting national initiatives that enhance employment, financial inclusion, and efficient service delivery.
