Region 6 Makes Significant Progress in National ID Registration

PSA Iloilo collocated with the Iloilo City LCRO's BRAP activities in San Nicolas, La Paz, Iloilo City, supporting the info drive on Civil Registration and National ID, and providing joint Birth Registration Assistance and National ID registration.

Preliminary figures from the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) show that as of 30 June 2025, a total of 4,218,240 individuals in Western Visayas have completed their registration under the National ID System.

The breakdown by province is as follows: Aklan – 556,078; Antique – 551,846; Capiz – 698,650; Guimaras – 162,838; and Iloilo – 2,248,828.

This milestone reflects the PSA's sustained efforts to make National ID registration accessible across the region. In addition to operating fixed and mall-based registration centers, the PSA has actively collocated with other government agencies and joined caravans organized by local government units and national agencies. These collaborative efforts have brought registration services directly to communities, especially in remote and underserved areas.

Senior citizens, particularly those eligible under the Expanded Centenarian Act, continue to benefit from targeted registration activities, including home visits and community-based outreach conducted in partnership with local offices.

Residents may proceed to the following centers to register: the PSA Fixed Registration Center at Refindor Building, Osmeña Avenue, Brgy. Estancia, Aklan; the Antique Provincial Statistical Office at Eagles Place, Building 2, Bantayan Street, Brgy. II, San Jose, Antique; the PhilSys Center at CityMall, Roxas Avenue, Roxas City, Capiz; the Ground Floor of Galanto Building, Mosqueda Village, San Miguel, Guimaras; and in Iloilo City, at the PSA Main Office located at J. Villanueva Building, Iznart Street, and at the Lower Ground Floor, Main Mall Entrance 3, SM City Iloilo, Benigno Aquino Avenue, Mandurriao.

The PSA reminds the public that these totals are based on preliminary data and may be subject to adjustments following validation. Registration continues, and more residents are expected to be onboarded in the coming months through the agency's sustained field presence and inter-agency coordination.
