Fleri Eugenia Venus, a relative of both registrants, visited the PSA - Negros Occidental Provincial Statistical Office on 01 August 2024, asking for assistance in registering Asis, since the National ID is now

Upon receiving the request, the PSA – Negros Occidental PSO scheduled for a PhilSys Mobile Registration on Wheels at Brgy. Felisa, Bacolod City, and visited the homes of the octogenarian and nonagenarian, in response to its call of an inclusive identification system especially to Filipinos who are considered priority clients (senior citizens and persons with disabilities) and have difficulty reaching the PhilSys Registration Centers.
