

**Negros Occidental's** Inflation Rate for all income households slightly rise up to **2.3** percent from 2.2 percent in January 2024 and decline against February 2023 with 12.4 percent (Please see Figure 1). The increase was due to the slight hike in the year-on-year rate in the indices for some commodities like; Housing/Water/Electricity/Gas and Other Fuels at -5.7 from -7.2, Health at 2.5 percent from 2.2 percent,Recreation/Sports and Culture at 5.7 percent from 5.5 percent and Personal Care and Miscellaneous Goods & Services at 3.4 percent from 3.2 percent.

Lower Inflation were noted in the indices for Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages at 3.7 percent from 3.9 percent, Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco at 5.1 percent from 7.2 percent, Clothing & Footwear at 2.0 percent from 2.3 percent, Furnishing/Household Equipment & Routine Maintenance at 5.2 percent from 7.0 percent, Transport at 0.1 percent from 0.5 percent, and Restaurants & Accommodation Services at 9.8 percent from 10.4 percent.

Relative to their annual rates in the previous month, these commodities retained their previous months annual growth rate;

- a. Information & Communication,
- b. Education Services, and
- c. Financial Services.



**In Bacolod City**, Inflation Rate for All Income Households also exhibited an increase to **3.1** percent from 2.5 percent in January 2024 and decrease against from February 2023 at 11.2 percent. (See Figure 2.).

The rise up was attributed by a slight increase in the indices of some commodities from January 2024; Clothing & Footwear at 9.3 percent from 6.5 percent, Housing/Water/Electricity/Gas and Other Fuels at -0.9 percent from -4.2 percent, Transport at 0.8 from - 1.4 percent, Information & Communication at 0.9 percent from 0.3 percent, and Recreation/Sports & Culture at 6.2 percent from 5.9 percent.

Relative to their annual rates in the previous month, lower inflation rates were observed in the indices of the following commodities:

- a. Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages,
- b. Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco,
- c. Health,
- d. Restaurants & Accommodation Services, and
- e. Personal Care and Miscellaneous Good & Services.

The indices of the rest of the commodities retained their previous months annual growth rates.
