Highlights of the Nueva Valencia Population: 2024 Census of Population

Date of Release: 08 August 2025 Reference No.: 25PSA-0679-SR87

The total population Nueva Valencia as of 01 July 2024 is 43,822 based on the 2024 Census of Population (2024 POPCEN). The total population accounts for about 22.7 percent of the province's population in 2024.

The 2024 population of Nueva Valencia is higher by 1,051 compared with its population of 42,771 in 2020. This is more than the population of 39,810 in 2015; and higher by 5,970 compared with the population of 37,852 in 2010. See *Table 1*.

The population of Nueva Valencia increased by 0.58 percent in a span of four years, on average, during the census years 2020 to 2024. By comparison, the rate at which

Of the 22 barangays in Nueva Valencia, the largest barangay in terms of population size is Brgy. Calaya with 3,678 individuals. It is followed by Brgy. Poblacion with 3,617 people, and Brgy. Lanipe with 2,979. *See Table 4.*

Meanwhile, Brgy. Canhawan is the least populous barangay in Nueva Valencia with 962 persons, followed by Brgy. Panobolon with 1,123 persons and Brgy. Igdarapdap with 1,158 persons. Santo Domingo and Tando also belong to the least populous barangays of Nueva Valencia, with 1,218 and 1,256 people, respectively.

population, based on the 2024 Census of Population. This was followed by Nueva Valencia with 43,822 persons (22.72%), and Jordan with 40,647 persons (21.07%).

Meanwhile, Sibunag registered the smallest population share in the province, with 23,787 persons, or 12.33 percent of the provincial total.
