Highlights of the Sibunag Population: 2024 Census of Population

Date of Release: 11 August 2025 Reference No.: 25PSA-0679-SR90

The total population Sibunag as of 01 July 2024 is 23,787 based on the 2024 Census of Population (2024 POPCEN). The total population accounts for about 12.3 percent of the province's population in 2024.

The 2024 population of Sibunag is higher by 625 compared with its population of 23,162 in 2020. This is more than the population of 22,158 in 2015; and higher by 4,222 compared with the population of 19,565 in 2010. See *Table 1*.

Date: 11 August 2025

The population of Sibunag increased by 0.64 percent on average, in a span of four years (2020 to 2024). By comparison, the rate at which the municipality's population grew during the period 2010 to 2015 was higher at 2.40 percent.

Of the 14 barangays in Sibunag, the largest barangay in terms of population size is Brgy. Sebaste with 2,677 individuals. It is followed by Brgy. Maabay with 2,565 individuals, and Brgy. Ravina with 2,223. *See Table 4.*

Meanwhile, Brgy. Inampologan is the least populous barangay in Sibunag with 179 persons, followed by Brgy. Bubog with 810 persons and Brgy. Oracon Norte with 1,014 persons.

Across municipalities, Buenavista recorded the highest population in Guimaras with 54,352 persons, accounting for 28.18 percent of the province's total population, based on the 2024 Census of Population. This was followed by Nueva Valencia with 43,822 persons (22.72%), and Jordan with 40,647 persons (21.07%).

Meanwhile, Sibunag registered the smallest population share in the province, with 23,787 persons, or 12.33 percent of the provincial total.
