




Volume of Production (in MT), by Subsector & by Province










COMMERCIAL FISHERIES





Aquaculture covers operations involving all forms of raising and culturing fish and other fishery species in marine, brackish and freshwater under controlled conditions

covers operations that make use of boats of more than three gross tons

Marine Municipal - covers fishing operations carried out without the use of boat or the use of a boat of three (3) gross tons or less

Inland Municipal - catching of fish, crustaceans, mollusks and all other aquatic animals and plants in inland water like lakes, rivers, dams, marshes,
