Production- the number of tended/raised animals disposed for slaughter or dressing including animals shipped-out for slaughter or dressing (in "head or bird" and in "liveweight equivalent")

Livestock- refers to farm animals kept or raised for consumption, work or leisure. For purposes of census and surveys, livestock covers only those that are tended and raised by an operator.

Poultry- is a collective term for all domesticated avian for the purpose of food consumption, or the carcass of such avian are processed for human consumption.
